Memories of **Alan Noad**



From the beginning Alan was a very active member of the Festival Team. He took a great interest in School Art (and all things artistic). Alan and his wife, Janet also produced our Festival programme for many years.

Alan worked on various matters for the Festival such as contact with local shops, and publicity. Alan was a tremendous force in encouraging shopkeepers to participate and contribute. His persuasional skills could open doors (and tills!) with ease.

It was Alan who organised our Scarecrow competitions, and who managed our links to the churches (mainly because he was also the main feature writer for the ICN at the time).

By mid 2010's, Alan was less able to contribute but he was always there, pedalling down to the Village on his bike, to lend a hand and offer advice.

Alan was a keen photographer and many of us will remember him with camera around his neck capturing moments that would be included in Festival programmes, ICN and promotional material.

His tireless efforts led to Alan being awarded the Ickenham Festival Shield in 2004. This acknowledged not only Alan's work with The Festival, but also his huge support to The Churches, Home Guard Club and Neighbourhood Watch. The Shield is dedicated to those who demonstrate "The Spirit of Ickenham Festival" – and Alan Noad was one of our brightest stars in that regards.
