Back in the mists of time, when Ickenham was a sleepy backwater, and The Ickenham Festival was a fledgling of a concept thought up to celebrate our Ickenham community, Bristol Myers, donated a Swakeleys House Shield to The Ickenham Festival with a view for it to be awarded to individuals that have contributed to the community "In The Spirit Of The Festival."

Subsequently it has been awarded, firstly on a biannual basis, and then more recently, annually, to individuals that in the view of The Festival Team fit that description. Even more recently it has also

been awarded to groups, clubs or associations for that same contribution.

With the departure of Bristol Myers from Swakeleys, the shield was renamed The Ickenham Festival Shield and once awarded to its new recipients it is returned to the display case in Ickenham Library, just inside the main door, along with the citation for the current holder.

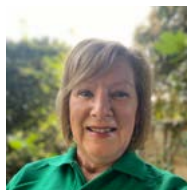
Ickenham Festival Team
